Rick Adolph has his **Advanced National, National and Goal Keeping Level I** diplomas from the

National Soccer Coaches of America (NSCAA). He is head soccer coach of the boys' and girls' teams at Ooltewah High School and teaches physical education and wellness. He has been coaching for 19 years, coaching players from U-5 teams to players at the collegiate level. He assisted the men's team at Lee University for three years. Rick also played professionally for a club in Bangladesh. He played collegiately where he was an All-American for 2 years and the NCCAA Soccer Player of the Year in 1988. Rick Adolph was previously the head soccer coach at Cleveland High School for 11 years before making the move to Ooltewah High School in 2006. He has 14 years of camp experience; directing Ooltewah OWL Soccer Camp for the past 2 years, Cleveland Raider Soccer Camps for 7 years, working camps in Detroit, MI, at Lee University, and for TSSA. He was also on staff with Tennessee ODP for several years.

CAMP DESCRIPTIONS

CAMP I - Elementary

For players who have completed grades K, 1, 2, 3, 4 or 5. Skills and techniques will be taught and reinforced through small-sided games and other fun activities to reinforce skills, techniques and small group tactics. Campers will be grouped according to age/ability.

NOTE: Finishers of 5th may choose **CAMP I** or **CAMP II**.

CAMP II - Middle School

For players who have completed grades 5, 6, 7 or 8. We will develop and improve individual skills and techniques in all areas. Developing proper technique is essential for all players. Small-sided games will be used, as well as other fun activities, for reinforcement. Small group tactics and decision making will also be covered.

GOAL KEEPERS: attend GK session at **CAMP III**.

NOTE: Finishers of 8th grade may choose **CAMP II** or **CAMP III**.

CAMP III - High School

For players who have completed grades 8 and higher. More advanced skills and techniques will be introduced, practiced and incorporated with individual, small group and team tactics, up to 11v11. This will include decision making and speed of play.

ATTENTION GOAL KEEPERS: There will be specialized training for middle and high school age players at **CAMP III**.

TO ENROLL: Return the attached application form and either the non-refundable deposit (remainder due on the first day of camp) or full payment for the soccer camp of interest. Enrollment could be limited so please register as early as possible to ensure your place.
